

# INCAS Launchpad

The first phase of INCAS development has just been completed and will be released at the INCAS Launchpad session at GLF in room 251 on Saturday afternoon from 15:30 to 16:15.

The first results from INCAS will show net greenhouse gas emissions from REDD+ activities on all of Indonesia's forests and peatlands. Results have been produced for the whole country and for all 34 of Indonesia's provinces. This represents the most detailed known account of greenhouse gases ever compiled for all of Indonesia's forests and peatlands. It provides detailed and credible information to help build investor confidence in Indonesia's REDD+ efforts and also inform the development of effective emissions reduction policies and programs.

The INCAS has been developed by the Indonesian Ministry of Environment and Forestry, with support provided through a unique partnership with the Australian Government and the Center for International Forestry Research (CIFOR). This support is delivered through close working relationships between Indonesian officials and national experts, supported by Australian and CIFOR experts. The support constitutes targeted capacity building, technology transfer and exchanges of expertise between the two countries and CIFOR.
