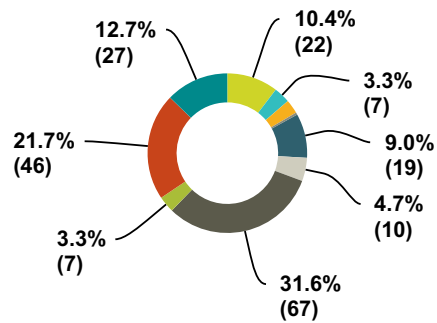

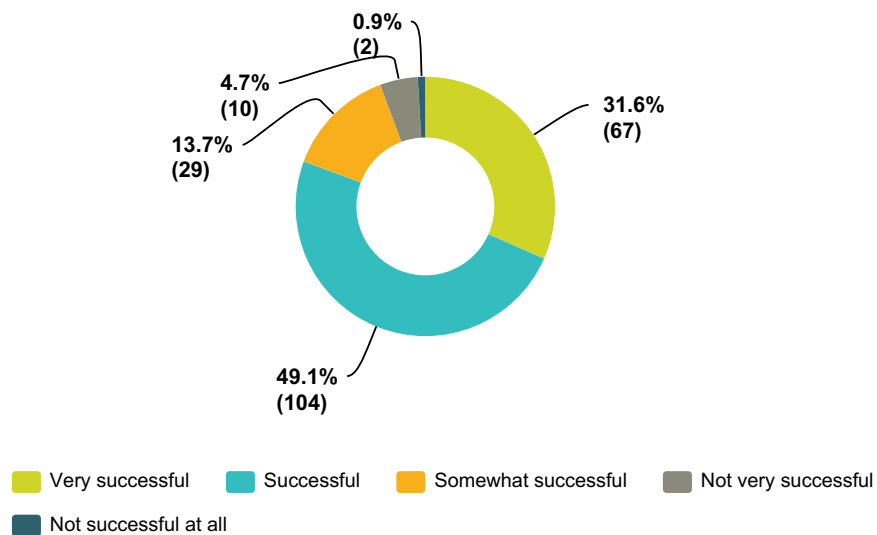

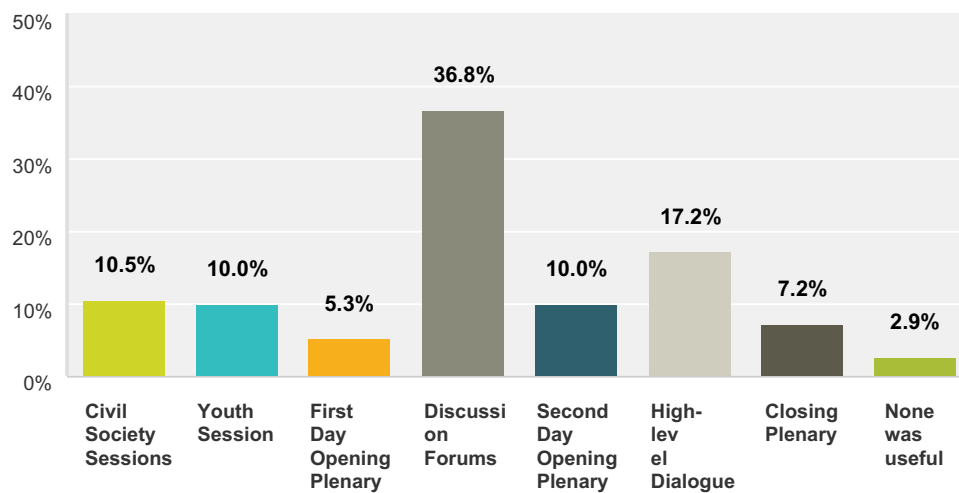
## Q2 How would you rate the event overall?

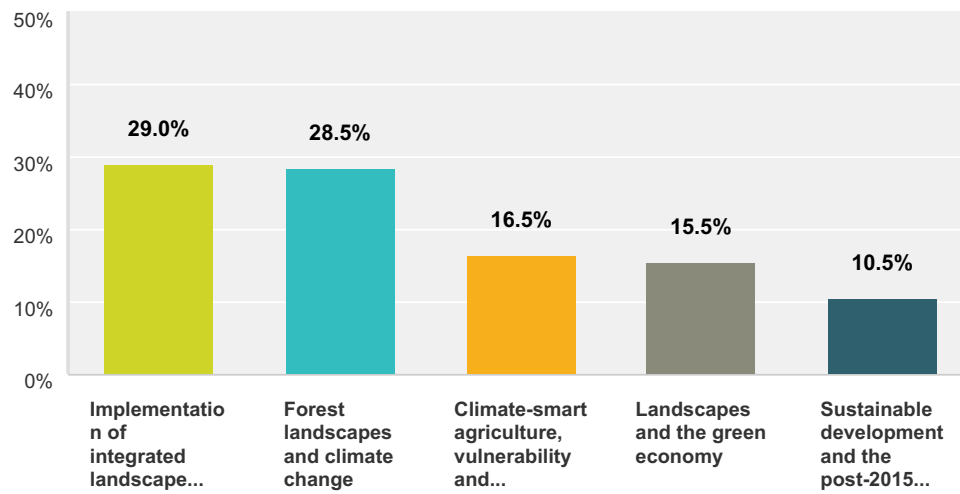
### Q3 Which session type was most valuable for you?

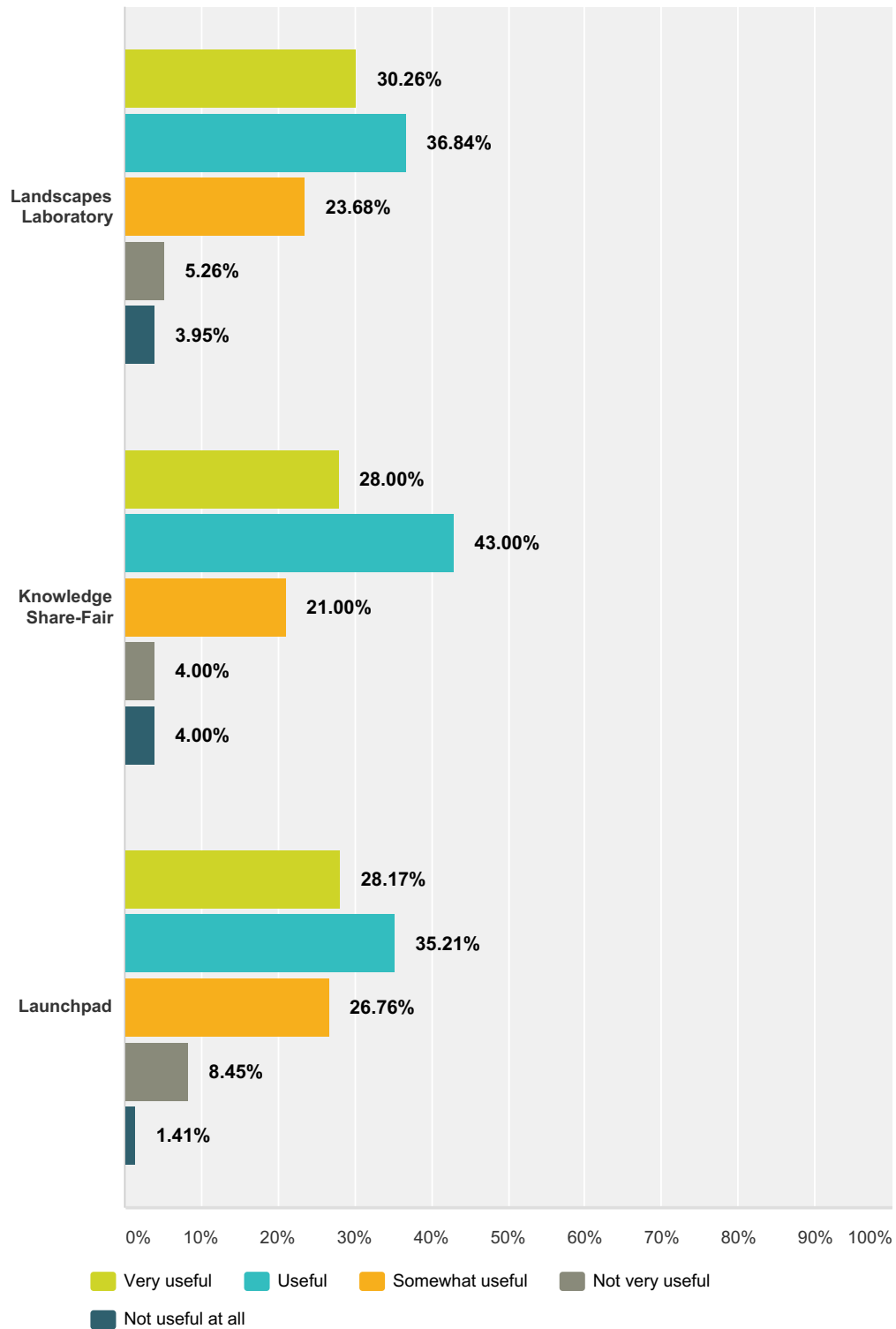
## Q5 Which of the Forum themes was most interesting to you?

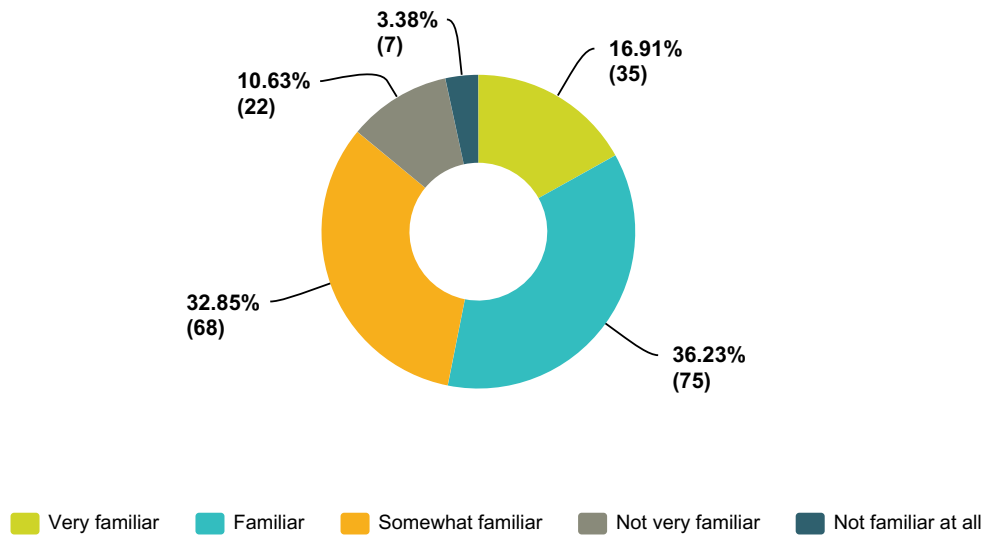
## Q6 Did you attend any of the 2014 Global Landscapes Forum innovations? If yes, how useful was the opportunity for you?

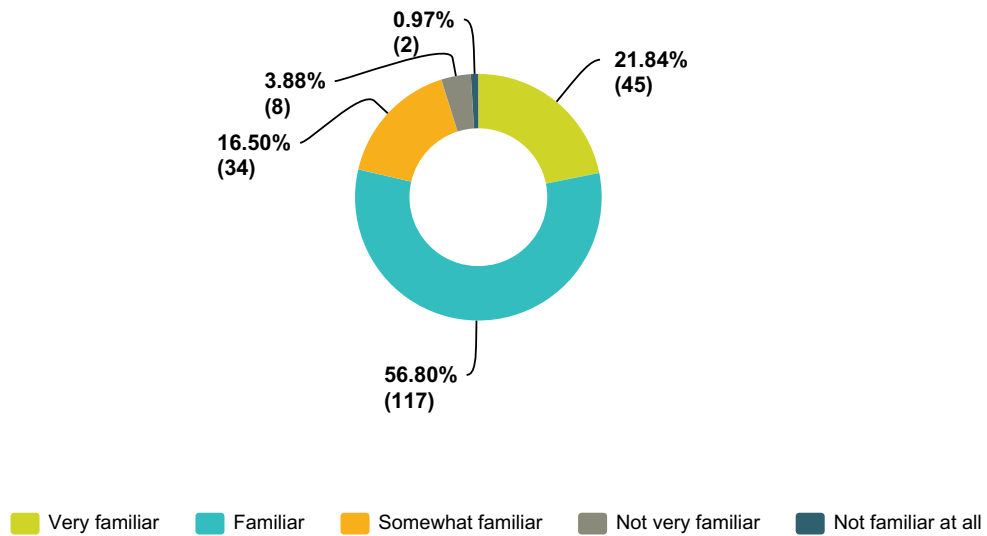
### Q7 How familiar were you with the implementation of integrated landscape approaches before attending the Forum?

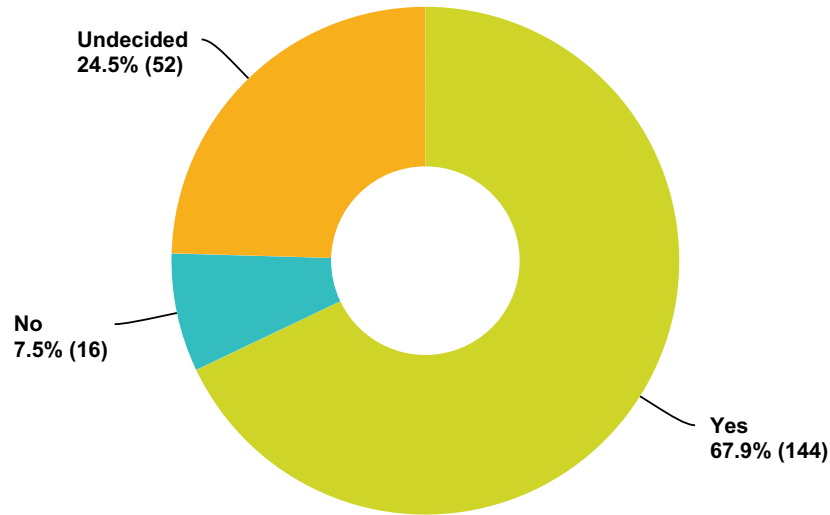

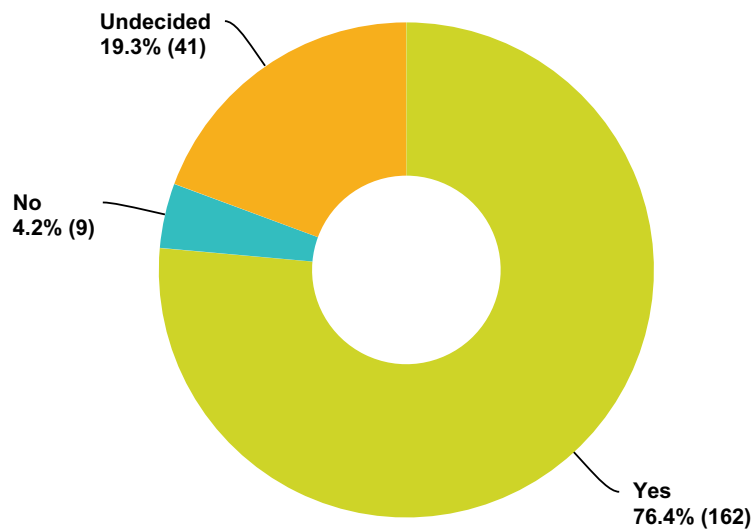

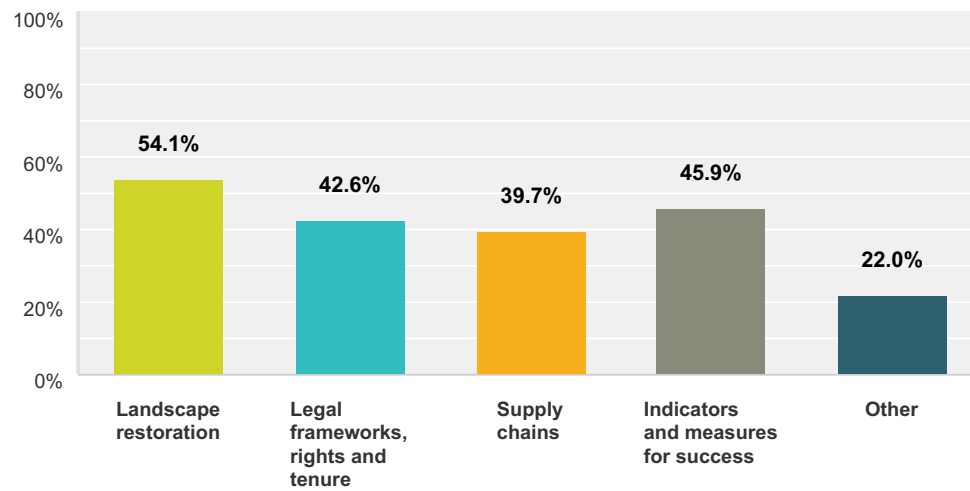
### Q12 Should the Forum continue to take place alongside the UNFCCC Conference of Parties?

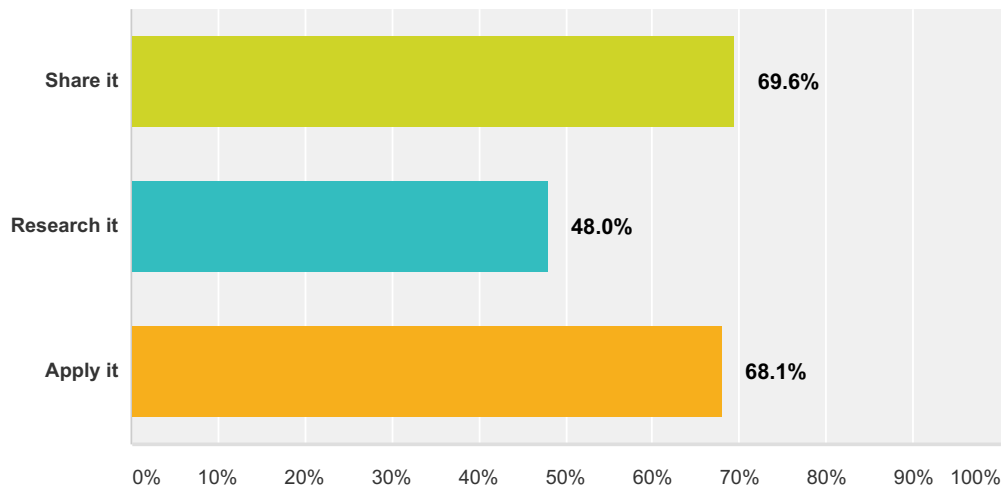
### Q13 Which of these potential themes should the Forum focus on in 2015?
